Crochet Witch

Double knit yarn 50g balls, black, white, purple & green, a small section of red yarn for the mouth. (You will have yarn left over) wadding for stuffing Size 3.5 / E crochet hook

Stitches used in this pattern:
 Magic circle
 Single Crochet
Chain up / Foundation chain
 Slip stitch

Sewing skills in the pattern
Backstitch & satin stitch
Top stitch for joining pieces together

Head & Body (Starting with white yarn)



Start - Row 1

Start with the magic circle, chain up 1 and crochet 8 single crochets onto the circle, slip stitch together and pull the circle closed. (Total 8 stitches)

Row 2 (Increasing)

Chain up 1, work 2 single crochets into each stitch, slip stitch closed (Total 16 stitches)



Chain up 1, work a single crochet into the first stitch, work 2 single crochets into the next stitch and repeat working 1,11,1,11 all around the circle, slip stitch closed. (Total 24 stitches)

Row 4, 5, 6, 7,

Chain up 1, work a single crochet into each stitch, slip stitch closed.





Row 8 (Reducing the stitches)

Chain up 1, work a single crochet into the first stitch, crochet the next 2 stitches together with a single crochet, repeat all the way round the circle, slip stitch closed. (Total 16 stitches)

Row 9 (Reducing the stitches)

Chain up 1, work a single crochet into the first stitch, crochet the next 2 stitches together with a single cro-

chet, repeat all the way round the circle, slip stitch closed. (Total 12 stitches)

Row 10 (Change yarn colour to black)

Chain up 1 crochet and work a single crochet into each stitch, slip stitch together. (Total 12 stitches)

Row 11

Chain up 1 crochet and work a single crochet into each stitch, slip stitch together. (Total 12 stitches)

Row 12 (Increasing)

Chain up 1, work a single crochet into the first stitch, work 2 single crochets into the next stitch and repeat work-



ing 1,11,1,11 all around the circle, slip stitch closed. (Total 18 stitches) **Row 13, 14**

Chain up 1 crochet and work a single crochet into each stitch, slip stitch together. (Total 18 stitches)

Stuff the head section with wadding. Sew in the loose yarns and trim.



Row 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23

Chain up 1 crochet and work a single crochet into each stitch, slip stitch together. (Total 18 stitches)

Row 24 (Reducing)

Chain up 1, crochet every 2 stitches together with a single crochet, slip stitch closed and finish off. (Total 9 stitches)

Stuff the body and sew the small circle closed. Sew a guideline with a running stitch around the hairline.

Hair (Purple yarn)

Row 1

Foundation chain 22 stitches.

Row 2

Chain up 1, work a single crochet into each chain. (22 stitches)

Row 3

Chain up 20, slip stitch into the first stitch, chain up 20, slip stitch into the next stitch, continue for the following 20 stitches.

Leave enough yarn at the end to sew the hair on along the previously marked out hairline.

Pin the hair in place and using a darning needle sew on securely.











Hat (Green Yarn)



Row 1

Start with the magic circle, chain up 1 and crochet 6 single crochets onto the circle, slip stitch together and pull the circle closed. (Total 6 stitches)

Row 2 (Increasing)

Chain up 1, work 2 single crochets into each stitch, slip stitch closed (Total 12 stitches)

Row 3, 4, 5

Chain up 1, work a single crochet into each stitch, slip stitch closed.

Row 6 (Increasing)

Chain up 1, work a single crochet into the first stitch, work 2 single crochets

into the next stitch and repeat working 1,11,1,11 all around the circle, slip stitch closed. (Total 18 stitches)

Row 7

Chain up 1, work a single crochet into each stitch, slip stitch closed.

Row 8 (Increasing)

Chain up 1, work a single crochet into the first stitch, work 2 single crochets

into the next stitch and repeat working 1,11,1,11 all around the circle, slip stitch closed. (Total 27 stitches)

Row 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14

Chain up 1, work a single crochet into each stitch, slip stitch closed.

Row 15

Chain up 1, work 2 single crochets into each stitch, slip stitch closed (This creates the brim of the hat)

Row 16, 17, 18

Chain up 1, work a single crochet into each stitch, slip stitch closed. Finish.

Stuff the hat lightly with wadding and sew on along the hairline.



Legs x 2 (Green Yarn)

Row 1

Foundation chain 22 stitches.


Row 2, 3, 4, 5

Chain up 1, work a single crochet into each stitch.

Finish.

Sew the legs along the length of the crochet piece.

Feet x 2 (Green Yarn)





Row 1

Start with the magic circle, chain up 1 and crochet 8 single crochets onto the circle, slip stitch together and pull the circle closed. (Total 8 stitches)

Row 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8.


Chain up 1, work a single crochet into each stitch, slip stitch closed.

Finish.

Stuff, and sew the end closed.

Sew the foot to the leg and then the leg onto the bottom of the witch doll base, close to the front, so as the doll will have a base to sit on.

Finish off the foot with a small criss-cross lace up stitch and a small bow, with the black yarn.



Arms x 2 (Black & White Yarn)

Row 1

Foundation chain 15 stitches.

Row 2

Chain up 1, work a single crochet into each stitch.

Row 3, 4

Turn, chain up 1, work a single crochet into each stitch.

Row 5

Turn, chain up 1, work a single crochet into the side of the crochet by picking up a stitch just after the turn and pick up a stitch for each line of crochet. Working with the single crochet you should end up with 4 crochet stitches.

Row 6, 7, 8.

Turn, chain up 1, work a single crochet into each stitch.



Pinafore Dress (Green & Black Yarn)

Row 1

Foundation chain 15 stitches. join together with a slip stitch.

Row 2

Chain up 1, work a single crochet into each stitch and slip stitch closed.

Row 3

Chain up 1, work 2 single crochets into each stitch, slip stitch closed. (Total 30 stitches)

Row 4

Chain up 1, work a single crochet into each stitch, slip stitch closed.

Row 5

Chain up 1, work 2 single crochets into each stitch, slip stitch closed. (Total 60 stitches)

Row 6

Chain up 1, crochet a single crochet into each stitch, slip stitch closed.

Row 7

Chain up 1, crochet a single crochet into each stitch, slip stitch closed.

Row 8

Change colour yarn to black.

Chain up 1, crochet a single crochet into each stitch, slip stitch closed.

Row 9

Chain up 1, crochet a single crochet into each stitch, slip stitch closed.

Finish and sew in the excess yarn.

Pinafore top

Row 10

At the top of the skirt pick up a single crochet stitch, work 4 more single crochets into the next 4 stitches.

Row 11, 12, 13, 14

Turn, chain up 1, work a single crochet into each stitch.





Pinafore straps

Row 15

Turn, chain up 1, work a single crochet into the next 2 stitches.

Row 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23

Turn, chain up 1, work a single crochet into the next 2 stitches.

Finish.

2nd Pinafore strap Row 1

Pick up a single crochet, work a single crochet into the following stitch.

Row 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9

Turn, chain up 1, work a single crochet into the next 2 stitches.



Sew the straps in place at the back of the skirt section of the pinafore dress.

Face

Using a small amount of black yarn sew two small eyes in place and red yarn for the mouth.

Back stitch for the mouth and satin stitch for the eyes.
