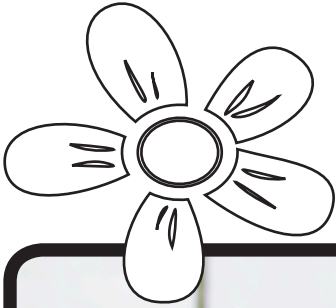


# Sweetie Collar

## Crochet Pattern

# Sweetie Collar

Gauge 9 stitches x 4 rows = 2" x 2"

## Yarn

Yarn used in the pictures Spring Crochet Assortment by Lidl / Colour light blue

Cotton yarn

2 x 50 gram balls or 1 x 100 gram ball

## Accessories

2 buttons (1/2" diameter)

## Crochet hook:

4 mm / G6

## Stitches abbreviations:

Chain stitches ch(s)

Slipstitch (sl st)

Double crochet (dc)

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**Foundation row**

Chs 32.

**Row 1:**

Work 1 dc into the 3rd stitch, work 1 dc into each stitch (30 dc in total)

**Row 2:**

Turn. Ch 2. Work 1 dc into each stitch until you have completed the line.

**Row 3 - 37:**

Turn. Ch 2. Work 1 dc into each stitch until you have completed the line.

You should have a crochet panel 18" x 7.5"

**Row 38:**

Turn the panel of crochet on its side, ch 2, work 1 dc into each space along the length of the panel. (77 stitches in total)

**Row 39:**

Turn. Ch 2. Work 1 dc into the first stitch, work 2 dcs into the 2nd stitch, work 1 dc into the 3rd stitch, work 2 dcs into the 4th stitch. (Repeat alternating with 1 dc and 2 dcs into the stitches all the way to the end of the line)

**Row 40 - 42:**

Turn. Ch 2. Work 1 dc into each stitch all the way to the end of the line.  
Sl st to finish.

Using a darning needle sew all of the yarn threads back into the collar.

Sew on the 2 buttons in between row 1 & 2, just above row 38. (refer to the picture on previous page)

Fold the 18" x 7.5" panel in half length ways and push the buttons through row 37, just above row 38.



**Finished collar size: Top 18", width 9 1/2", bottom 30".**
